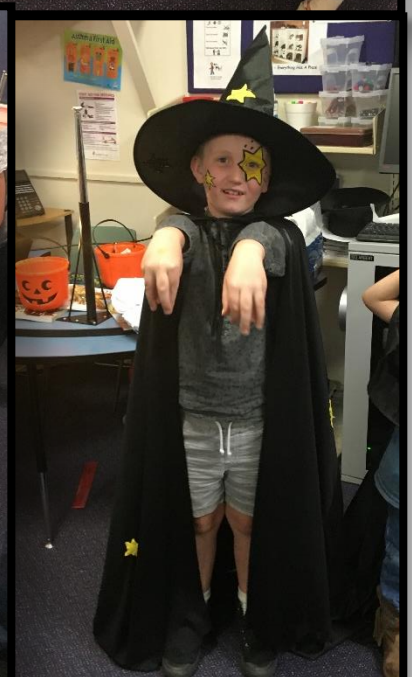
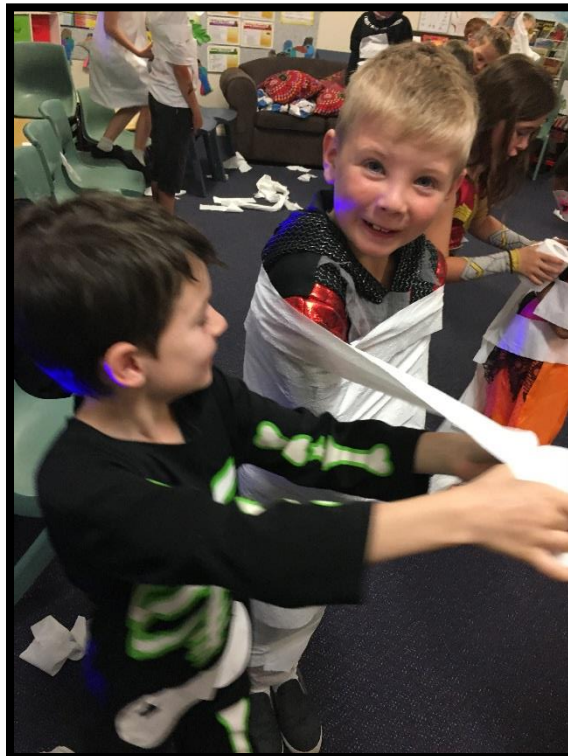
Nundle Amateur Swim Club

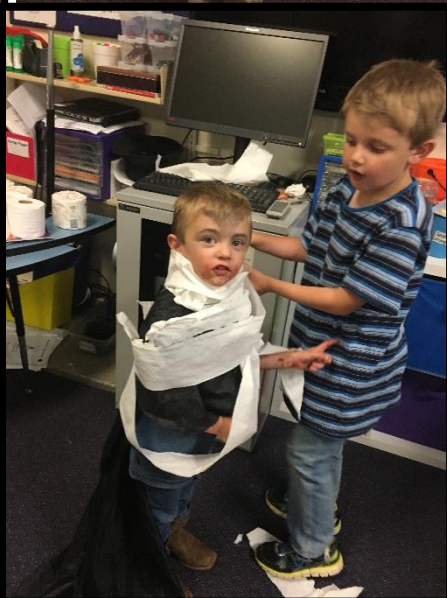
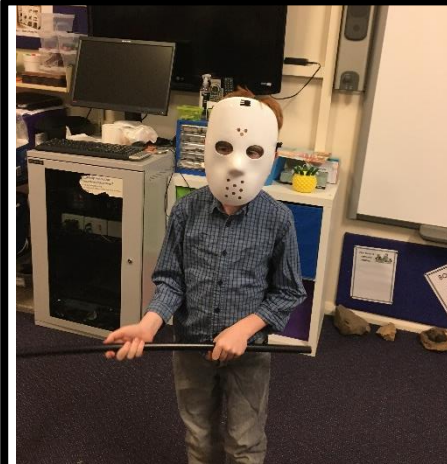
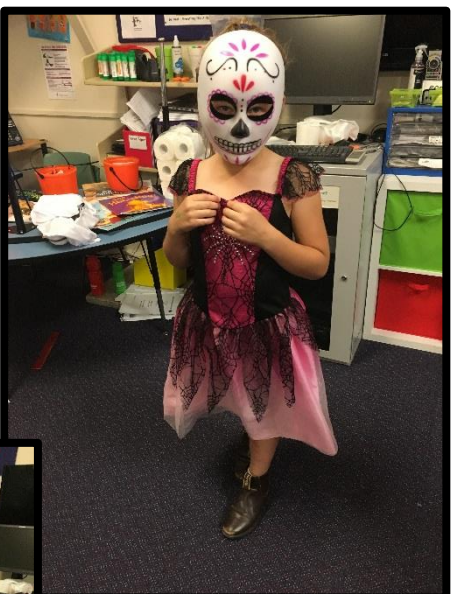
