Thank you to Mrs Leys and Steff McMahon for assisting with transport. Without your support, we would not have been able to access this program at THS.

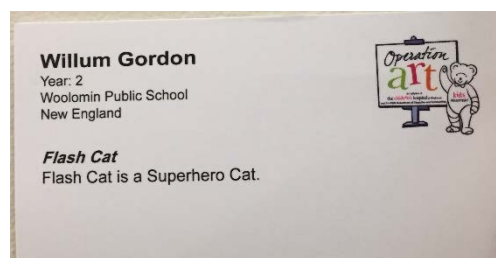
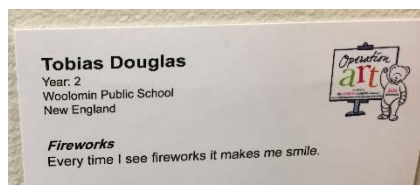


Operation Art Exhibition Success
