Remembrance Day

Last Friday, Woolomin School students, parents and staff held a Remembrance Day ceremony to commemorate and remember all Australians who have died as a result of war and to reflect on the ending of WW1 with the armistice. We were privileged to have Mr Mac McLeod as a special guest speaker at the assembly. Mr McLeod presented some very interesting information and facts about WW1 and spoke about the importance of the younger generation continuing traditions such as ANZAC Day and Remembrance Day. He also acknowledged the sacrifice and commitment made by the loved ones of local families in world conflicts.

Students in K-2 presented a lovely poem titled 'Poppy'. It was well presented and the students were delightful reciting their memorised lines. They did an amazing job. The Stage 2 class (3-4) read a shared text and when each student had finished reading they put a poppy on the silhouette of a soldier they had painted in class. The students reflected great progress in their reading of a very sophisticated text. The Stage 3 class (5-6) read persuasive texts that they had written in class. Each student presented his or her response to the question, "Why should we stop and remember?" The student responses gave adults present at the assembly hope for the future to know that our senior students understand the great sacrifice many soldiers and their families have made to ensure the safety and progress of others.

Our guests and students enjoyed a lovely morning tea of ANZAC biscuits and lamingtons after the ceremony.
