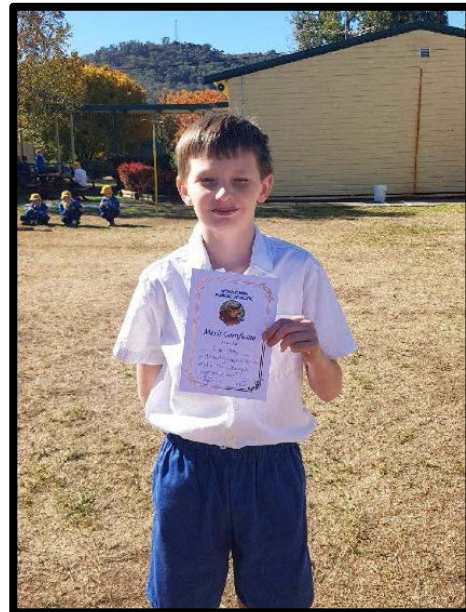
Miss Burford's Award

Amba Graham: Improvement when adding and subtracting numbers



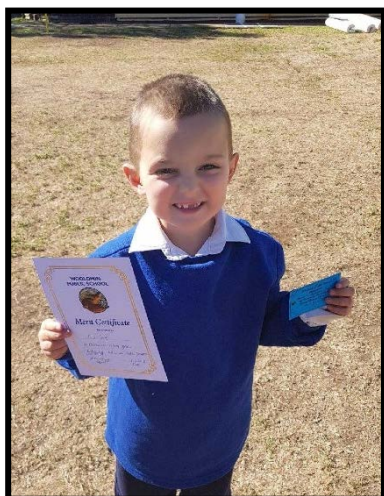
Principal's Award

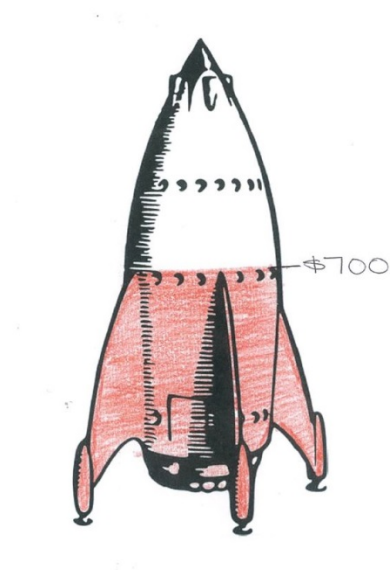
