We are all very proud of the amazing effort each competitor put into their race.





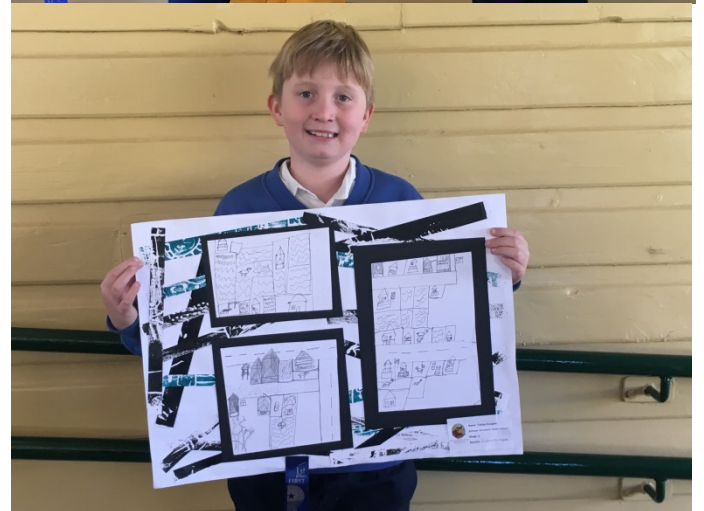
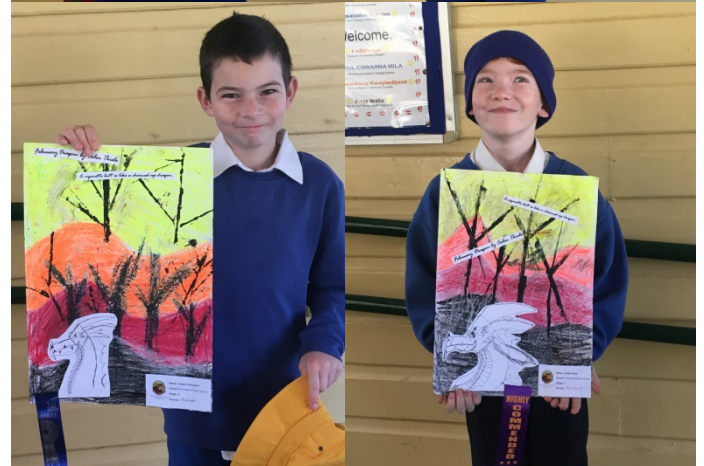
# Cops are Tops
